## LESSON GOAL

Students will rejoice that God is gracious and compassionate and will become more like Him.

## LESSON OBJECTIVES

Students will be able to:

- Explain why Jonah did not want to preach in Nineveh.
- Tell what happened to Jonah after he fled to Tarshish.
- List examples of God's mercy from the book of Jonah.
- Analyze what God taught Jonah from the plant and worm incident.

## KEY VERSE

"Now the word of the LORD came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, 'Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me.'" —*Jonah 4:1-2*
